

Curriculum

The Norwegian school in London relates to the curriculum in “Fagfornyelsen”, and makes its annual plans and thematic plans based on this.

The five basic skills; oral, reading, writing, arithmetic and digital skills are central in the curriculum and is integrated into the competence goals.

The curriculum aims for all students to acquire the five basic skills in all subjects so as to be able to acquire lifelong learning after graduation.

The basic skills are central to the school's assessment for learning in all subjects and have main focus in the development conversations every six months between teacher, student and parent.

The teachers have a strong focus on differentiation in teaching and use different methods with in assessment for learning. You can see our regulations for Assessment for learning under the regulations tab.

We also emphasize the British values; democracy, respect for the law, individual freedom and reciprocity respect and tolerance for different beliefs and worldviews.
