

Student Council

As part of the school's work with democracy, the student council is established every year.

All classes from 1-10 elect two representatives for the current school year.

They meet every 6-8. week or more often as needed. The student council elects a leader and deputy leader from among themrepresentatives.

The student council has its own form teacher with responsibility for leading the work in such a way that the students getexperience, knowledge and understanding in:

- Democratic processes and how these are managed
- Management
- How to behave in meetings and meeting management
- Representation

The student council leader and deputy leader of the student council represent the student council in board meetings for the school.

Minutes from the student council are sent to the teachers and the principal, and the principal gives written feedback.

The student council annually arranges various events and competitions such as chess tournaments, film evenings,table tennis tournament, indoor climate competition, etc.
