The school follows the Norwegian national curriculum, 'Kunnskapsløftet 2020', hereafter called LK-20, in its entirety. The curriculum is made and revised by the Norwegian authorities, see full curriculum here: <https://www.udir.no/laring-og-trivsel/lareplanverket/>

LK-20 clearly states which subjects that should be taught and the minimum hours of teaching that should take place in each subject, see curriculum link above.
